NOTIFICATION

Where it appears to the Governor of Punjab that land is likely to be required to be taken by Government at Public expenses, for public purpose, namely Additional land to be required for Constructing Canal Syphon at 94.671 of Kandi Canal Stage-II Village Meghawal Hadbast No. 296, Tehsil Garshanakar District Hoshiarpur.

It is hereby notified that the land in the locality described below is likely to be acquired for above purpose.

This notification is made under provisions of section-4 of land acquisition Act, 1894, to all whom it may concern.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the aforesaid section-4 the Governor of Punjab is pleased to authorize the officer for the time being engaged in the undertaking with their servants and workmen, to enter upon and survey any land in the locality and do all other acts required or permitted by that sanction.

Further in exercise of powers under the said Act the Governor of Punjab is pleased to direct that action under section-17(i) shall be taken in this case on the grounds of urgency and provisions of section 5(n) will not apply in regard to the acquisition of said land. The land in question is waste or arable, as Kanal Canal Extension from Hoshiarpur to Balachaur is being financed by Government of India under Central Loan Assistance through A.L.B.P. Scheme, which is to be completed within scheduled period to provide irrigation facility to Bernal area of Kandi tract of Hoshiarpur and Nawanshehar Districts.
